In the opinion of the Local Planning Authority, the width, siting and massing of the proposed extension in close proximity to the adjoining property will create a form of terraced development out of character and incompatible with the surrounding area contrary to policies BE1 and RES7 of the adopted Hinckley & Bosworth Local Plan and the Borough Council's Supplementary Planning Guidance on house extensions.

(b) <u>05/00534/OUT - Erection of 25 residential units (all matters reserved), Van Dieman Limited, 41/47 High Street, Earl Shilton - Mr. L. Hopkins</u>

Having received advice from officers that a response was awaited from English Heritage, in consequence of a submission from a third party that the former school building should be considered for listing it was moved by Mr. Bown, seconded by Mr. Hinton, and

<u>RESOLVED</u> - the response of English Heritage be awaited but, subject to officers taking into account the views and concerns previously expressed and the conditions outlined in the report, the Head of Culture & Development be delegated the authority recommended in the report.

The advice of officers was that this application was subject to conditions/information to cover these issues.
