(a) <u>05/00589/FUL - Residential development of 12 no. dwellings 113 Main Street,</u> <u>Ratby - Mr. Dave Hill</u>

Although generally supportive of this development concerns were raised regarding access to this site, the proposed design of the buildings and the need to engage in further discussions with interested parties.

In referring to contributions from the developer officers advised that the Primary Care Trust required a contribution of £2,755 towards improving existing health facilities and that contributions for open space would be paid at the commencement of the development.
