# 262 <u>MINUTES (P42)</u>

On the motion of Mr. Bown seconded by Mrs. Camamile it was

<u>RESOLVED</u> – the minutes of the meeting held on  $4^{th}$  October 2005 be confirmed and signed by the Chairman.

Mrs. Camamile, Mrs. Cook, Mr. Ellis and Mr. Hinton each declared an interest in planning application number 05/00834/OUT on the grounds that they were Members of the Primary Care Trust Scrutiny Committee.

#### 264 <u>BURBAGE DRAFT VILLAGE DESIGN STATEMENT (DRAFT SUPPLEMENTARY</u> <u>PLANNING DOCUMENT) (P44)</u>

Members' approval was sought to the above, prior to publication for a sixweek consultation period. Once finally adopted this document would assist in the determination of planning applications within Burbage.

<u>RESOLVED</u> – the draft Burbage Village Design Statement be approved for consultation.

# 265 <u>TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 - APPLICATIONS TO BE</u> <u>DETERMINED (P43)</u>

It was moved by Mr. Ellis, and seconded by Mrs. Wright, that the recommendations of the Head of Culture and Development contained in the schedule submitted, as amended by the list of late items, be approved.

Mrs. Camamile, Mrs. Cook, Mr. Ellis and Mr. Hinton, having declared an interest in the following item, left the meeting at 6.59 p.m. whilst this was considered.

(a) <u>05/00834/OUT – Extensions and alterations to existing hospital, Sunnyside</u> <u>Hospital, Ashby Road, Hinckley – Hinckley and Bosworth National Health</u> <u>Service Primary Care Trust</u>

Whilst welcoming the benefits of this facility within the Borough and agreeing the recommendation of the Head of Culture and Development that this application be permitted concerns were raised with regard to car parking provision, accessibility to the site by persons without cars and transport aspects.

The Highways Authority had raised no objection to the proposal but in view of Members' concerns the Head of Culture and Development undertook to have further discussions with that Body as to means of access and the possible provision of refuges/crossings on Ashby Road.

Mrs. Camamile, Mrs. Cook, Mr. Ellis and Mr. Hinton returned to the meeting at 7.20 p.m., at which time Mr. Bill left the meeting. Mr. Davis left at 7.23 p.m. at which time Mr. Bill returned.

(b) <u>05/00887/FUL – Installation of steel roller shutters and alterations to shop</u> front, Jan and Tom Wightman, 27 Regent Street, Hinckley – Jan and Tom Wightman

Whilst accepting advice from officers that this proposal was contrary to the Council's Supplementary Planning Guidance and to Policies BE1, BE7, BE8 and BE10 of the adopted Local Plan it was moved by Mrs. Wright, seconded by Mrs. Camamile and

<u>RESOLVED</u> – consideration of this application be deferred to allow for further discussions with the applicants and the Police with regard to more acceptable forms of shutters.

Mr. Davis returned to the meeting at 7.28 p.m. Mr. Bill and Mrs. Claridge left at 7.35 p.m.

(c) <u>05/00902/FUL – Extension and alterations to dwelling, 10 Oakdale Road, Earl</u> <u>Shilton – Mr. and Mrs. M. Iliffe</u>

Discussion arose as to the provisions of the adopted Supplementary Planning Guidance for Household Development with regard to extensions to semidetached properties and despite the officer's recommendation for approval it was moved by Mr. Bown, seconded by Ellis and

<u>RESOLVED</u> – this application be refused for the following reason and additionally the Head of Culture and Development examine the Supplementary Planning Guidance referred to insofar as extensions to the front of semi-detached properties were concerned.

- 1. In the opinion of the Local Planning Authority, it is considered that the proposed extension fails to respect the scale, design and character of the existing dwelling, resulting in an over-dominant, unbalancing and unsympathetic front addition, to the detriment of the appearance of the property itself, the pair of semi-detached dwellings of which it forms a part, and the street scene in general. The development would, therefore, be contrary to policies BE1 and RES7 of the adopted Hinckley & Bosworth Local Plan and the Council's Supplementary Planning Guidance on House Extensions.
- (d) <u>05/00985/FUL Creation of first floor balcony, Topps Wine Bar, 3 Chapel</u> Street, Barwell – Mr. D. Gardner

Mr. Ellis left the meeting at 7.50 p.m.

Although recommended for refusal concerns were raised with regard to the safety aspects of this proposal and it was moved by Mr. Hinton, seconded by Mr. Furniss and

<u>RESOLVED</u> – consideration of this application be deferred pending discussions with the Police to establish their views on this application.

(e) <u>05/00992/DEEM – Creation of disabled access and granite wall, land fronting</u> <u>24-28 Ratby Road, Groby</u>

Following a request from the Head of Culture and Development it was moved by Mr. Bown, seconded by Mr. Furniss and

<u>RESOLVED</u> – this application be withdrawn to allow for further discussions with Groby Parish Council, and to consult with the Police.
