(a) <u>06/00597/DEEM - 30-41 Peggs Close, Earl Shilton - Hinckley & Bosworth</u> Borough Council

Members felt that condition 6 should refer to 'management, support services and allocations policy' and condition 7 should include reference to the Borough Council's Housing Task Group both being agreed before development commences.

Conditions

- 6. Before any development commences, full details of the management, support services and allocations policy for the facility shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority, and the scheme shall be implemented in accordance with those approved details prior to the development being first brought into use and shall be maintained thereafter unless agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority;
- 7. Before any development commences, a liaison committee shall be formed to include representatives of the Borough Council, Earl Shilton Town Council and local residents to consider methods to minimise the impact of the development and provide advice to the Borough Council's Housing Task Group.

The meeting was adjourned at 7.12pm and reconvened at 7.20pm. Messrs D R Bown and Ellis returned to the meeting at 7.20pm.
