Apologies for absence were submitted on behalf of Mr B H Edwards, Mr M A Hall, Ms J E Price and Mr K Vessey and the substitution of Mr Collins for Ms Price was authorised in accordance with Council Procedure Rule 4.3.

#### 601 <u>MINUTES (P77)</u>

On the motion of Mr Bown, seconded by Mr Ellis it was

<u>RESOLVED</u> – the minutes of the meeting held on 6 March 2007 be confirmed and signed by the Chairman

#### 602 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Mrs Aldridge declared a personal and prejudicial interest in applications 07/00087/FUL and 07/00182/FUL.

Mr Batty explained that although he was not a member of the Planning Committee, he felt he should declare that he would speak in objection to application 06/01322/FUL.

#### 603 <u>TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 - APPLICATIONS TO BE</u> DETERMINED (P78)

The Committee considered a schedule of planning applications, together with a list of late items, and the recommendations of the Head of Culture and Development.

It was moved by Mr Ellis and seconded by Mr Crooks that the recommendations of the Head of Culture and Development contained in the schedule submitted be approved.

## (a) <u>06/01385/FUL – Sunnydene Works, Woodland Avenue, Burbage –</u> <u>Morris Homes East Midlands Ltd</u>

Members supported the officer's recommendation but it was requested that a note to applicant be added reiterating that maintenance of the hedge was a matter for the Parish Council and the Developer to agree separately.

<u>RESOLVED</u> – the application be approved subject to the execution of an Agreement under Section 106 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and Section 111 of the Local Government Act 1972 and an additional note to applicant with regard to maintenance of hedges.

## (b) <u>07/00044/FUL – Land Rear of 197 – 211 Sketchley Road, Burbage –</u> <u>Matthew Homes</u>

Although in support of the officer's recommendation, Members requested that a further condition be added with regard to boundary treatment to protect no. 201 Sketchley Road.

<u>RESOLVED</u> – the application be approved subject to the conditions contained within the report, and the following additional condition:

# **Condition**

No development shall take place until full details of both hard and soft landscape works have been submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority and these works shall be carried out as approved. These details shall include:

- (i) proposed finished levels or contours;
- (ii) details of all boundary treatment to the site including technical specifications of acoustic walls and/or fencing to mitigate noise impact on 201 Sketchley Road;
- (iii) hard surfacing materials.

Having declared an interest in applications 07/0087/FUL and 07/00182/FUL, Mrs Aldridge left the room at 7.12pm and returned at 7.29pm.
