## 364 UPDATE ON BARWELL CEMETERY MEMORIAL SAFETY INSPECTION

The Green Space Manager provided the Committee with details of the Council's intention to carry out works to inspect, make safe, or repair memorials from Barwell cemetery in consequence of advice received from the Health and Safety Executive to minimize risks within cemeteries. Memorial owners or relatives affected by any works had been advised to contact the Council's Cemetery Office for assistance. It was emphasized that any remedial work to make the structures safe would only be a temporary measure and discussion ensued as to the legal position arising from owners' liability.
