- the Head of Health and Environment and the Principal Licensing Officer be authorised to determine those applications where no representations have been received (as set out in appendix B to the report);

(iii) the scheme of delegations set out in the Council's Constitution be amended by the addition of the following:-

'To authorise the Head of Health & Environment to enforce the provisions of the Gambling Act, 2005, either generally or specifically, in accordance with the Act, relevant statutory guidance and/or codes of practice, and to authorise persons in accordance with Section 304 of the Act.'

'To authorise the Head of Health & Environment to act on behalf of the Licensing Authority as a Responsible Authority under section 157 of the Gambling Act 2005'; and

iv) the amendments to the Council's Constitution be recommended to Council for ratification on 22 May 2007.
