### 416 <u>20/00347/REM - LAND EAST OF PECKLETON LANE, DESFORD</u>

Application for approval of reserved matters (layout, scale, appearance and landscape) of planning permission 18/01252/OUT for 80 dwellings and details of the affordable housing scheme and onsite open space area scheme.

It was moved by Councillor J Crooks, seconded by Councillor Bray and

<u>RESOLVED</u> – permission be granted subject to the conditions contained in the officer's report and late items.

## 417 <u>20/00354/FUL - TEMPLE HALL FARM, BOSWORTH ROAD, WELLSBOROUGH</u>

Application for change of use of agricultural building to commercial use (B8) and relocation of access (part retrospective).

### 419 20/00191/FUL - PAYNES GARAGES LTD, WATLING STREET, HINCKLEY
